The term STEAME is the acronym for the words (Science-Technology-Engineering-Arts-Mathematics-Entrepreneurship)

The main purposes/objectives for which the Organization is established are the following:

- To promote professional development of teachers through certification programmes in the form of micro-credentials.

The Federation platform and STEAME Observatory

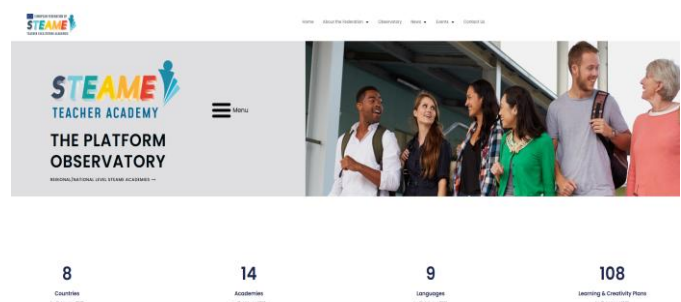

The Observatory with many STEAME-PBL resources are now available for all serving and student teachers.

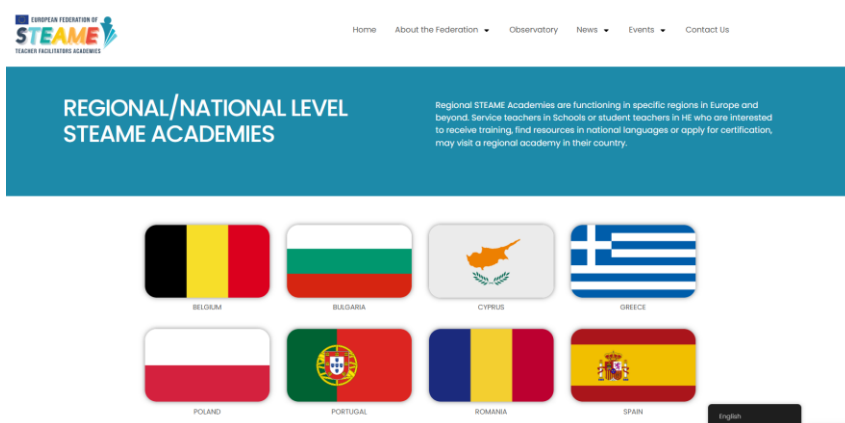
- 108 STEAME Learning & Creativity Plans are now available in 10 European languages. These include more than 100 learning videos with subtitles in 10 languages.

EUROPEAN STEAME TEACHER FACILITATOR CERTIFICATION

The STEAME Teacher Facilitator Certification in the form of a micro credential is available and offered by the European Federation of STEAME Teacher Facilitators Academies.

The **Path to Certification** can be viewed in this link [HERE](#). If there is a Regional STEAME Academy in your area the submission will have to be made through the regional academy. If there is no regional academy, then you may submit your application to the Federation directly.

The certification requirements are based on competence development and the success is based on evidence of competence and skill development. The certification can only be accomplished by serving or student teachers working in groups with minimum two teachers of different specialty in co-creation. There is no written examination but teachers have to develop a reporting together and submit it online together. Among the requirements is the study of the modules provided in the platform observatory, the development of a joint Learning & Creativity Plan and then implement it with groups of school students for a minimum of 6 hours.

The platform provides also an AI Assistant to help teachers create their Learning & Creativity Plan.
